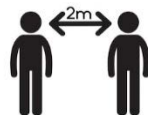

## Provincial Orders

Provincial Orders from Provincial Health Officer Dr. Bonnie Henry are still in place. These are to keep all British Columbians safe.

Social distancing is still in place, this means we should all limit contact with those outside our households. Maintain at least 2 meters between you and others if you are out.

## Cleaning Tips

Community members can practice routine cleaning of frequently touched surfaces (for example: tables, doorknobs, light switches, handles, desks, toilets, faucets, sinks) with household cleaners and disinfectants that are appropriate for the surface.



For disinfection, diluted household bleach solutions, alcohol solutions with at least 70% alcohol.
